### EveryStudent.com Goes French

The French Campus Ministry National Retreat was four days of evaluation, encouragement and planning for the future. One highlight of the retreat was the new evangelistic website for the French ministry.

In the United States, EveryStudent.com is a seeker-friendly website full of articles, stories and opportunities for students to ask questions about God, life and truth. The site gets thousands of visitors each month and is a great, non-threatening tool that can be used in evangelism. However, the site is totally in English and there clearly was a need for one in French.

The French Campus Ministry started the process of creating their own site in 2002. Over the past year, things have moved along sporadically. The French site looks and feels like the US site, but the French staff still have the daunting task of translating the large number of articles. In addition, they need to find email correspondents for students with questions. Needless to say, there was only partial momentum for the project.

At the retreat, Dan Workman, a STINT intern with years of computer and consulting experience, showed a power-point presentation that caught the attention of the campus staff. The presentation shared the vision of having posters and flyers linked to the site, how it could increase sowing and evangelism, how it could build a presence on new campuses and open a new window of opportunity to the whole French speaking world.

Dan made some simple posters using some of the ESC ideas translated into French, and within minutes staff from each of the seven campus

locations in France wanted to know how they could get copies of them.

Staff member Bart Lillie explains, "I felt like I was watching God at work and this was the magic moment. In less than an hour, this project went from back burner to full speed ahead. They decided to professionally print the posters and flyers and when the count was totaled, 137,000 flyers and 2200 posters were in the works. I'm excited about the possibilities that the French staff team has with these new opportunities. This first printing of posters and flyers will be able to expose more than 150,000 students to this website and a chance to hear the truth of the gospel."

## Deux ABOUT THE FUTURE

We are filling out applications to become Campus Crusade for Christ staff. This means we'd return to the U.S. in early June for new staff training and also be given a new assignment. It's exciting to investigate different possibilities, one of which is continuing to encourage the use of the internet as an evangelistic tool internationally.
