In the book "The Touch of Jesus" by Paul Eshleman, Samoan Taing shared the story of her family's narrow escape from the Khmer Rouge in Cambodia. Through God's miraculous grace and provision they were able to make it to America. "Our little boy had never slept in a bed. We had told him since he was old enough to understand, that our Lord had everything and He would take care of us. So when he saw this bed, he asked if that was the bed of our Lord. We told him that our Lord had given this bed for us to sleep in. He was so excited." When he saw his first car he immediately asked, "Does our Lord have a car? Can we ask Him for one?" They did and the Lord provided it for them their first days in the United States. This story truly speaks to our hearts – may our faith be like theirs! Our Lord is not short on resources. He will provide everything we need as we step out once again in faith to serve Him in Europe.
