work with internet or the Jesus Film ministry. Another colleague tapped Dan on the shoulder, "Hey, I need

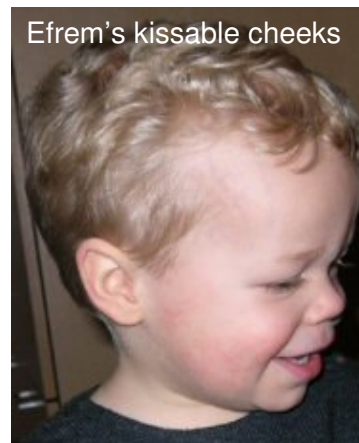
