
## Un LIFTING UP LOVE

God's will. And He's allowed me to go up to the mountain. And I've looked over. And I've seen the Promised Land. I may not get there with you. But I want you to know tonight, that we as a people will get to the promised land!"

These words were spoken by Martin Luther King hours before his life was taken by an assassin's bullet, forty years ago. We want to highlight his extraordinary life
