There were many elements involved, many ways through which God could speak, and by the time we reached our final questions our guests around the table felt comfortable. Here were the questions: What sort of fruit do you want your life to bear? What is your vine, your source of life and inspiration? We were talking about things that really mattered, a perfect opportunity for Christians to tell about their life in Christ. And 25-30 non-believers heard the gospel in a way they hadn't before. Even better still, 16 people said they would be interested in doing a Bible study in John. God is working!
